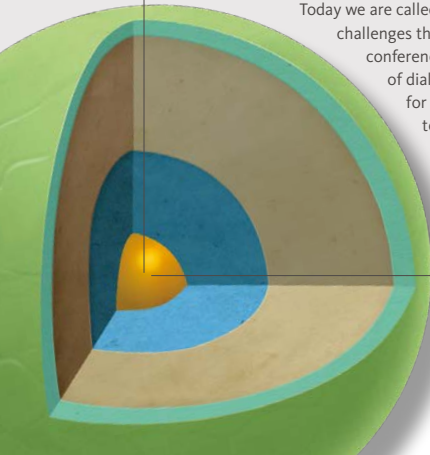
It's an exciting and necessary challenge: it has to do with the art of "knowing how to respond" of our behaviors and choices to the increasingly demand for a fairer world for all.

In 2007 he received the Wolf Foundation Prize in the Arts, "for his constantly inventive career as an artist, educator and activist whose restless intelligence has created prescient forms of art to contribute to a new understanding of the world". In 2004 the University of Turin awarded him an honorary degree in Political Science. On this occasion the artist announced what has become the most recent phase of his work, Third Paradise. Günther Reifer

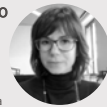

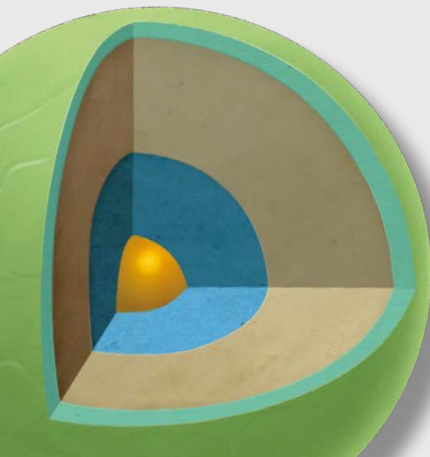

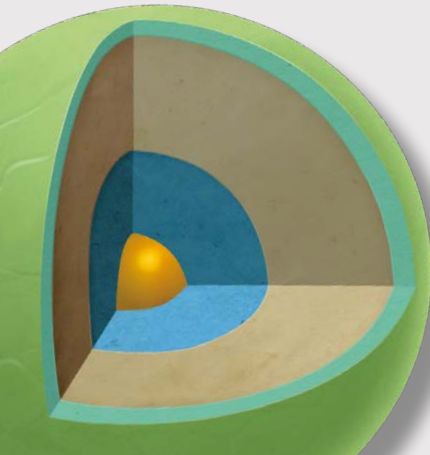

The third paradise

In 2003, Michelangelo Pistoletto wrote the manifesto of the Third Paradise, and draws the symbol, consisting of a reconfiguration of the mathematical sign of infinity. Between two adjacent circles, representing the opposite sides of nature and artifice, a third center circle is placed, in order to represent the generative womb of a new humanity, an ideal overcoming conflicts in which nature and artifice are placed in the current society.

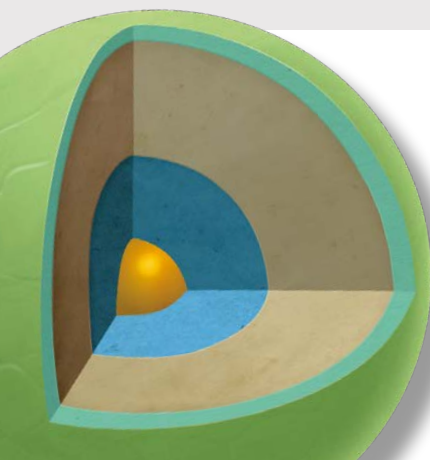
